Access to Information & Protection of Privacy Office, Dept. of Justice and Public Safety (JPS)

Access to Information and Protection of Privacy – Coordinator Training

Under the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015* (ATIPP Act), all municipalities must appoint an ATIPP Coordinator to respond to access to information requests and promote privacy. Most municipalities appoint their Town Clerk as their ATIPP Coordinator.

Winter training sessions for municipalities are planned in Conception Bay North, Clarenville, Marystown, Gander, Springdale, Deer Lake, and Labrador City. Watch for an email from atippoffice@gov.nl.ca with exact dates and locations.

The ATIPP Office also offers ATIPP Coordinator training at the Confederation Building in St. John's and Quarterly Communities of Practice meetings with ATIPP Coordinators.
