

Public Transit

The public transit stream will primarily build new urban transit networks and service extensions that will transform the way that Canadians live, move and work.

To be eligible, projects must meet at least one of the Program Outcomes below:

Program Outcomes

- Improved capacity of public transit infrastructure
- Improved quality and/or safety of existing or future transit systems
- Improved access to a public transit system

Limitations, Exclusions & Federal Requirements

A Public Transit project is not eligible if it involves inter-city bus, rail, port or ferry infrastructure that is not part of a public transit system.¹

In addition, public transit and active transportation projects that connect citizens to a public transit system must also:

- be consistent with a land-use or transportation plan or strategy; and
- be consistent with the approved plans of regional transportation bodies (where applicable)

¹ Public transit is considered to be a distinct mode of transportation conveyance that generally refers to the movement of passengers only within an urban or municipal setting.
