Requirements

4 Your fuel cache must be readily identified with a highly visible sign placed at the approved cache site. The sign must contain your company's name and approval number.

Service NL requires that you maintain this log of fuel stored at your cache site. An up-to-date copy of the log should be available at your base camp location (if applicable) and your company's local office if you have one, or head office.

This record must be made available to officials of the Government Service Centre upon request. Failure to keep an accurate up-to-date log may result in the fuel cache approval being revoked.
